INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSONS

We provide highly skilled specialist instrumental Music Tutors who are reflective practitioners and receive ongoing peer support and mentoring. In addition, all tutors are fully DBS checked and have had OCR checks where relevant. This enables your pupils to access high-quality music lessons, that are fully supported by the Bristol Beacon education team. We provide free lessons for Children in Care and with an Educational Health Care Plan and an Instrument Hire Scheme, so all children in your school that want access to a music lesson should be able to do so.

MANAGING MUSIC LESSONS IN YOUR SCHOOL

We can manage music lessons through a parent pay and lesson management system, SpeedAdmin. This removes the financial and administrative burdens of managing instrument lessons in your school and means that we can timetable lessons and deal directly with parents for payments and enquiries. No more chasing parents!

PLANNING FOR MUSIC AND TEACHER TRAINING

No school improvement plan is complete without a 'School Music Education Plan' (SMEP). Developed with Ofsted and the Department for Education, every school should have an up-to-date plan and we can write this plan with you. Developing expertise in your team is vital to supporting an ongoing musical culture. Bristol Beacon collaborate with local and national partners to lead training to help develop and diversify your curriculum.

MUSIC ADVANCEMENT SUBSIDY

Schools that join the membership are eligible to apply for a Music Advancement Subsidy of up to £900. This investment can be used to support the advancement of music in your school through one of our Music Advancement Subsidy strands.

MUSIC ADVANCEMENT SUBSIDY STRANDS:

Schools can use their music advancement subsidy to access focussed support through one of our Music Advancement Subsidy strands.

- Music Lessons: This strand allows schools to use their subsidy to provide reduced price/free music lessons to their pupils up to the value of the subsidy. This strand can also be used to provide up to 3 hourlong workshops per year to inspire musical creativity in your school.
- Instruments/music equipment: This strand allows schools to purchase up to £900 worth of musical instruments for use in their school.

- Ensembles: Bristol Beacon tutors will run a school ensemble for a year to kick-start ensemble opportunities in your school!
- Music Theory/composition: This strand will allow schools to access support with GCSE/A Level Theory/Composition and to access up to 30 hours of planning/support either in a whole class setting, or as an extracurricular activity for small groups or 121s needing targeted support.
- CPD and Training: Schools accessing support through this strand can use their subsidy to purchase training for their staff to support music making. This can include a half-day consultancy, training, or attendance by one of our team at a staff meeting or INSET day. Bristol Beacon also offers a comprehensive range of CPD and Training opportunities on a wide range of topics, including Ofsted Deep Dive, Music Curriculum etc. We can also offer bespoke training for your school.
