Free tickets to amazing concerts in Beacon Hall

We are also collaborating with these organisations to also offer workshops/ rehearsals and free tickets for selected concerts throughout the year which will only be eligible to membership schools. This year, events included pupils from membership schools received a free workshop with Rachel Leach and LSO players and attended a rehearsal with Sir Simon Rattle and met John Adams before attending a free concert including a premiere of a new John Adam's composition.



Partnerships

Creating partnerships with organisations across the UK is an integral part of Bristol Beacon's work. In academic year 23/24, we worked with Shlomo, Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra, London Symphony Orchestra and many others! These organisations create amazing opportunities for your young people, whether it is a workshop at Bristol Beacon or a small and intimate gig with an orchestra! The possibilities are endless! Some partners we are working with this year are Ezra Collective, London Symphony Orchestra, Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra, and a host of BBC events including BBC National Orchestra of Wales and BBC NOW.

Access to performance

As a Bristol Beacon Musical Schools Member, you will get access to a 10% discount on tickets to selected Bristol Beacon concerts, particularly our classical season. Your students will also be able to access workshops and some performance opportunities with some of the visiting artists that we will be hosting at Bristol Beacon in 2024/25.

Beacon Music Centre Sheet Music Library

You will also automatically become a member of our extensive sheet music library at Beacon Music Centre. We have a large collection of classical music and singing scores (including musical theatre) which can be accessed through our Exams and Library Coordinator.

75% discount on instrument hire for school instrument loans

Your membership allows your school to access a 75% discount on instruments which are on loan to the school. This can include any instrument that is kept on school premises. This is dependent on stock and availability.

Access to livestreamed workshops

Access livestreamed workshops lead by our tutors. We can run workshops on vocal coaching, DJ skills, Music Theory support and instrument specific workshops.

Support and guidance meetings

We know that teaching music or running a department can feel overwhelming. We also understand that the needs of each school, department head, and staff member are different. This is why we are available for support and guidance meetings. In these meetings, you set the priorities and we will take you through how the hub can offer support. We can also be a professional but friendly ear when you need to talk through any aspects of your music provision. We have a range of staff with a wide range of experiences and knowledge to take you through the issues affecting your department.

Secondary Heads Network meetings

Our Secondary Heads Network is open to all secondary schools in Bristol, you do not need to be a member to attend. The network meets quarterly and gives you an opportunity to share learning and resources with other music leads working in secondary settings.



Instrumental Music Lessons (without timetabling)

We provide highly skilled specialist instrumental Music Tutors who are reflective practitioners and receive ongoing peer support and mentoring. In addition, all tutors are fully DBS checked and have had OCR checks where relevant. This enables your pupils to access high-quality music lessons, that are fully supported by the Bristol Beacon education team.

Instrumental Music Lessons (with timetabling)

We can timetable the music lessons in your school through the parent pay and lesson management system, SpeedAdmin. This removes the financial and administrative burdens of managing instrument lessons in your school and means that we can timetable lessons and deal directly with parents for payments and enquiries. No more chasing parents! We will also manage sending yearly reports to your students in the summer term. We charge a small timetabling fee directly to your school and then handle the rest. Please note, timetabling is done in blocks of 20 students per school, please see our terms and conditions for details around the space and time requirements we have for your school before timetabling is done. Please see our remissions policy for details about the discounts and bursaries that we provide for the students in your school.



Discounted music technology bundles
