We look forward to welcoming you to Creative Health in Action on Friday 18 October at Bristol Beacon.

1. Access desk

Where?

- Found at the Box Office on Ground Floor.
- Access this at ground floor level via our entrance on Trenchard Street, or via stairs/lifts from any level in our Bridgehouse building.

What? Here you will find our friendly staff team, who will be able to provide:

- information about the performances and activities and suitability for your needs
- information about accessible viewing spaces and accessible routes throughout the venue and seating options.
- earplugs. (Please note ear plugs are for children aged 12+. It is the responsibility of the parents to bring ear defenders for children under 12.)

2. Venue Layout / Seating plans

Creative Health in Action takes place across Bridgehouse (Foyer building).

Bridgehouse

There are seven areas in Bridgehouse:

- Lower Ground Floor (level Lower Ground)
- 2. Kennedy Room (level Lower Ground)
- 3. Sound Lounge (Ground floor level)
- 4. Stalls Bar (level 1)
- 5. Film room (level 1)
- 6. Terrace Bar (level 3)
- 7. Quiet space (level 3, bridge E)

Spaces in Bridgehouse will be set up as follows:

- Lower Ground Floor with a raised stage in theatre style seating format
- 2. Kennedy Room an exhibition of community artwork, with some seating available.
- 3. Ground Floor Sound Lounge will be set up for workshops and a Human Library with some seating available
- 4. Stalls Bar information and stands area with soft seating available
- 5. Film Room film screening, with some seating available
- 6. Terrace Bar workshop space with some seating available

7. Quiet space – quiet corner of the building with soft seating

3. Hearing loops and assistive listening system

Hearing induction loops are installed at Bristol Beacon box office. Hearing aids should be turned to the 'T' or '3' position to access the loops.

4. Blind and partially sighted customers

Large print programmes

Copies of our programme and venue information in large print and high contrast can be downloadable from our website. We will also have large print programmes available on request at the Access desk.

5. Assistance Dogs

Assistance dogs and emotional support animals are welcome at Bristol Beacon.

6. Stewards and Audience Safety

Our friendly stewards and audience safety team, will be across all Bristol Beacon performance spaces from the start to the very end of Creative Health in Action.

Please do talk to stewards if you have any questions, for example, where to find the toilets, how to get to performance spaces or any access support you might require.

Stewards will be wearing blue polo shirts with a Bristol Beacon logo and our audience safety team are easily identifiable.

If you are unable to find a steward, please make your way to the Box Office in Bridgehouse, Ground Floor, where there will be people permanently stationed and able to help.

7. Access register

Bristol Beacon holds an Access Register. We encourage Deaf, disabled and neurodivergent people to join our register so we can help you buy tickets and attend events in the future.

Once registered, you will enjoy priority booking and a free ticket for your Personal Assistant to support you during your visit.
