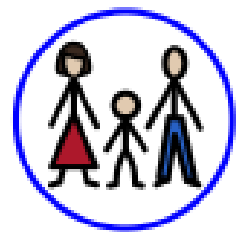


## Welcome to our Winter Family Dance Party – Ice Ice Baby!

### When is it happening?

There are two parties:

Lights



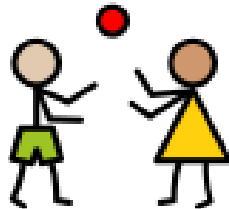
Haze/

### Where to come?

The Ice Ice Baby Family Dance Party will be taking place in the Lantern at Bristol Beacon.

You can enter Bristol Beacon through the Main Entrance on Colston Street or the back entrance on Trenchard Street.

The Main entrance on Colston Street looks like this:



The party is happening in the Lantern is on level 1. You can take the lift or the stairs. It looks like this:



The difference is it will be an open floor with no chairs. The curtains will be drawn so we can see the lights!



There will be some soft seating for colouring one end of the Lantern if you need to rest/relax.

If you need a bit of time out, you can visit a quiet space on the stalls bar on the same level.

## How can I get there?

Bristol Beacon is located at Trenchard Street, BS1 5AR.

Disabled parking can be found in the NCP Trenchard Street car park.

A lay-by for curb-side drop-off is immediately outside Bristol Beacon on Pipe Lane.

Our accessible toilet facilities are found on all levels and are signposted in the building.

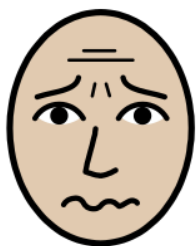
Registered assistance dogs and emotional support animals are allowed.



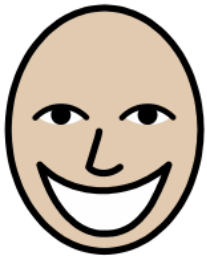
## Who will be around to support?
