

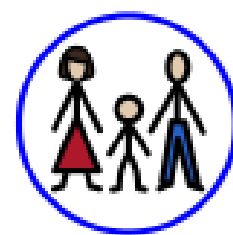
Welcome to our Family Dance Parties!

Dance Party 2: 11.30am – 12.30pm

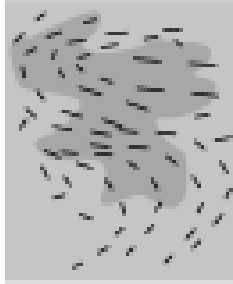
What will happen at a Family Dance Party?

Lights



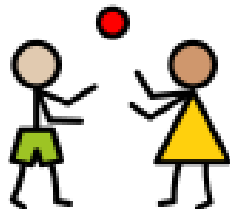
Haze

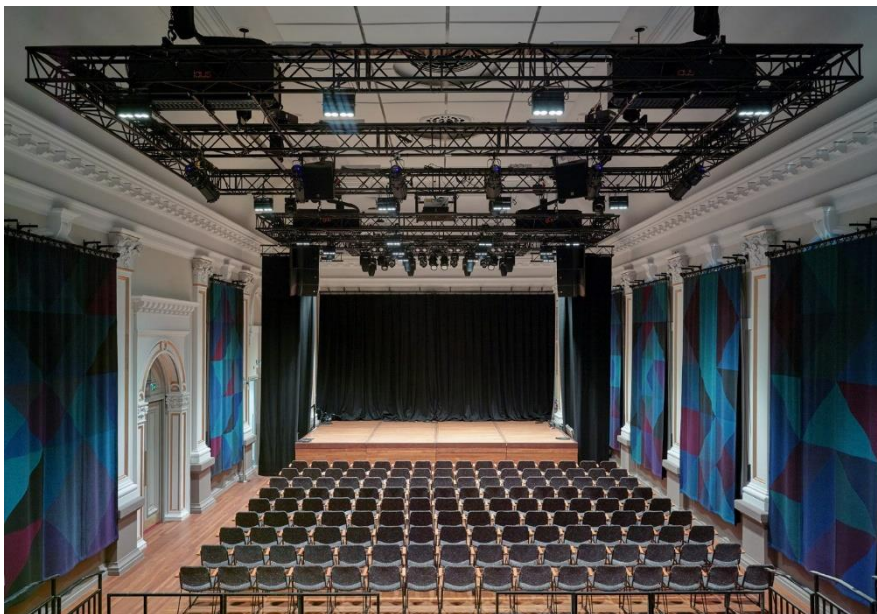
Where to come?

The party is happening in an venue called The Lantern Hall. This is on level 1 and you can take the stairs or the lifts.

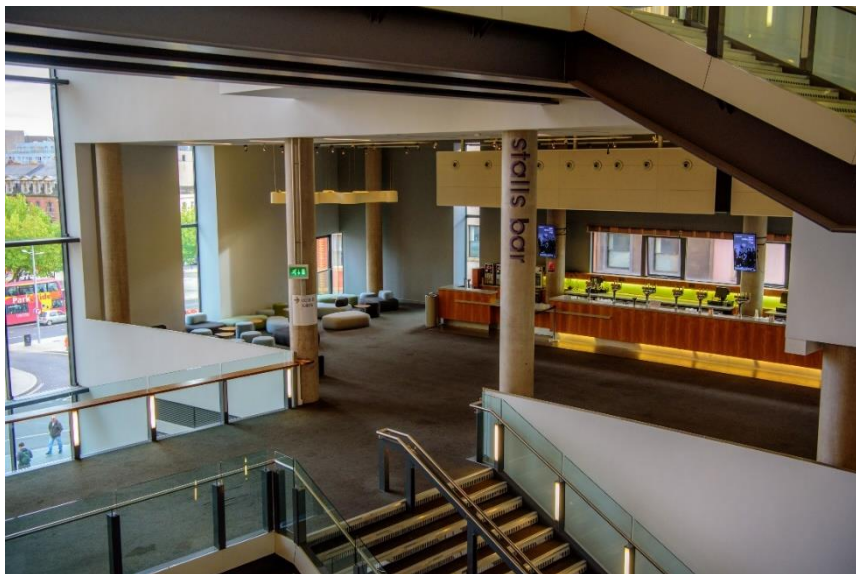
Lantern Hall looks like this. For the party we will have a clear floor with no seats.

Our accessible toilet facilities are found on all levels and are signposted in the building.

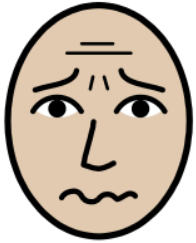
Registered assistance dogs and emotional support animals are allowed.



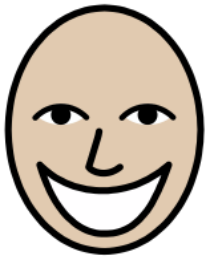
Who will be around to support?
