Please arrive via the Bridgehouse entrance on Colston Street. This entrance looks like this:

For those **driving**, <u>Trenchard Street multi-storey car park</u> is 50m away directly behind Bristol Beacon. For those on **bikes**, racks are available on Trenchard street, Colston Street, and on the city centre promenade. If you take the bus, there is a city centre bus stop is 250m from Bristol Beacon where most bus services stop.

Timings and how the day will run:

You are welcome to arrive at Bristol Beacon any time from 9am.

The check-in desks can be found on the Lower Ground floor, next to Bristol Loaf café.

At check in we will let you know where to leave your bags and coats, make sure you are happy with the vocal part you have told us you'd like to sing and chat through any access or support needs you may have.

The concert element of the day will start at 7pm. We expect to be finished by 8pm. There will be no interval. Any friends or family wishing to attend the concert will need to purchase a ticket via the Bristol Beacon <u>website</u> or at the Box Office on the night of the concert.

Claire Alsop – Musical Director and Arranger. Claire has arranged all the music, is our Musical Director and will be playing keyboard in the band.

Natalie Cooper- Vocal Leader. Natalie will be teaching us the music and leading the sectionals for upper voices. She will also be conducting you for the concert.



Nav Arles – Vocal Leader. Nav will be teaching us the music and leading the sectionals for lower voices. He will also be conducting you for the concert.

Alongside Claire, Natalie and Nav, we will be joined by our **pro- band of West End musicians**, and **three soloists** for the concert. You can find out more about our professional artists <u>here</u>.

Learning the music

We will be teaching the songs on the day using notated music. We will be splitting into separate groups throughout the day to go through each part, so please do not worry if you are not able to read music.

To help familiarise yourselves, we would like to encourage everyone to listen and have a singing along with the rehearsal tracks before the day. See below.

Accessing and printing/downloading the music.

All the songs are now available to view and download via our website <u>here</u>. On our website you will find four music packs:

- Soprano
- Alto
- Tenor
- Bass

We will have some printed copies available on the day, but we are trying to reduce printing as part of our positive climate action agenda. You can find out more about our journey to become Net Zero by 2030, here.

Rehearsal tracks:

You will also find the rehearsal tracks to sing along with online. Again, these are split into soprano, alto, tenor and bass parts. Please note there is no rehearsal track for the Massive Musical medley, as this is a song we will learn and sing with our audience on the day.

Each rehearsal track has the sound of a piano, and a single vocal line which will match the part you're singing. Have fun!

Dress:

Please wear whatever you feel comfortable in, for the workshop. For the concert, we would like to encourage you all to wear a bright block colour top.

Refreshments and bars:

We will provide you with hot drinks and water throughout the day. There will be multiple water stations set up in Bridgehouse and across the venue, so please bring a water bottle. Please note you are not able to take hot drinks into Beacon Hall or Lantern Hall.

Bristol Loaf, our amazing café will be open all day. The bars will open at 6pm before the start of the concert.
